## **Liberals need to come clean on \$250m worth of missing health money**

The Canberra Liberals need to tell the Canberra community before Saturday what their plans are for the missing health millions.

Minister for Health Katy Gallagher said that the Liberals health policy keeps changing.

“One day it’s this, the next day another version appears and now two days out from the election, the Treasury documents have confirmed that the Liberals will not spend all the health growth money on health commitments,” Ms Gallagher said.

“From all the work we have already done we know that we need to provide a minimum \$27 million increase to health services every year just to keep up with the demand.

“There is \$300 million available for the Liberals to spend on health over the next four years yet they have only allocated \$50 million of this to the health portfolio - \$250 million short of what is actually needed to sustain our health system.

“Under the Liberals flawed plan they will not be able to meet demand that is here now let alone future increases in demand and the work to build our new health infrastructure will slip way behind schedule.

“This will send the public health system into crisis and leave it completely unable to meet the health tsunami that we know is on the way.” Ms Gallagher said
